MEN&MAHLER



"Ohhhh... I wish I could experience being a man – just for a couple of days..." says the only female performer in the show, while she watches - and tries to understand - the male game that is going on... The question is... Will she understand anything?

24 euro-pallets, 9 work lights, 8 muscular men of 6 different nationalities (aged between 20 and 52 years / weight 50 to 100 Kg.), a seductive singer, an apple and 50 meters of rubber band ... These are the main ingredients in Granhøj Dans' latest production, MEN & MAHLER. It is yet another example of the "Granhøjnian" theatrical universe on which nothing is holy and where anything can happen. The men's harsh body language and naughty behavior is in contrast to Mahler's wistful, solemn music, while the woman observes and comments the action with Attenboroughish distance. In the performance Granhøj Dans examines, as usual, aspects of the human nature through an easy, direct and humorous stage language.
